#### **Research and Extension Activities**

In the academic year 2019-20 also we have been very successful in facilitating active research in the campus. The results of our efforts in this direction are indicative in the total number of 62 research publications came out from the campus in 2019-20. All the newly installed sophisticated instruments have started working in full-fledged manner, supporting the researchers and other students. The PG and UG projects undertaken as part of curriculum also have been greatly supported by these instrumental facilities. Our students could become more successful in winning the Student ASPIRE fellowship awarded by the Directorate of Collegiate Education; 19 of our students have availed the fellowship in 2019-20. Two major projects; one supported by KSCSTE and another one by Govt. of Kerala also have been awarded in 2019-20.

# **Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)**

IQAC has taken all measures to ensure quality and well-being of the institution. The cell has conducted feedback surveys from students in a

more systematic manner. The data compilation and assessment also have been made more objective and evaluative. The Statistics department of the college has offered a technical support to IQAC in performing data compilation and processing. Communications to teachers regarding the feedback from students also have been done in a prompt manner. Further actions in the case of those instances where feedback is not satisfactory, also has been duly initiated. Construction of several new buildings like English honours block and new science block with instrumentation centre are either completed or in the final stage with the timely support and involvement of IQAC. All the seminars and workshops organized by various departments in the college have been guided and facilitated by IQAC. Discussion on the title 'our college - the way forward' (Two sessions; on 08-07-2019 and 25-07-2019) and Seminar on 'Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)' held on 18-11-2019 were some of the programmes directly coordinated by IQAC for the benefit of staff and students. Like in the previous years, in 2119-20 also, IQAC has served a great role in the overall growth and development of our institution.

# **College Development Council (CDC)**

The College Development Council (CDC), the apex body of the college which plans developmental activities of the institution, has served a great role in the maintenance and growth of the institution in 2019-20 also.

Many urgent repair and renovation works have been undertaken by the CDC. The body consisting of District Collector as chairman, Principal as secretary and treasurer, nominees of teachers, PTA, college union chairman and other eminent personalities nominated by the Director of Collegiate education as members have convened the routine meetings in the year 2019-20 also. The council foresees the developmental activities in the campus in coming years and acts as an advisory body to the planning committee.

#### **National Service Scheme**

National Service Scheme aims to cultivate ideas of social welfare in the minds of students and to provide an unbiased service to the society. During the academic year 2019-20, NSS units of Govt. College for Women, Thiruvananthapuram has adopted a novel approach targeting a holistic development of student fraternity in the campus. The activities of 2019-20 are discussed in detail here.

In the month of June 2019, as a part of district administration project C5 (Change can change Climate Change), which aims at a sustainable lifestyle to mitigate the effects of climate change, students from our NSS Units volunteered the programme "UDYANAM" along with 'Haritham' Eco- Club at Peroorkada. As a part of the programme, volunteers cleaned the residential area and planted saplings there. On June 21st, we observed International Yoga day in the premises of our college. We also participated in the Yoga Day celebration conducted in association with Nehru Yuva Kendra. On June 25th, as a part of observance of reading week, our NSS Units conducted a programme 'Vayanapakshacharanam' and a book exhibition with the support of Library Council of our College. We organised a 'Paper basket' making class on 28th June for the students of 6th and 8th standard of St. Helen's School, Thiruvananthapuram.

In the month of August, we conducted a number of programmes. On August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 53 NSS Volunteers participated in the programme in the field 'Nattumarangal Nanmarangal' inaugurated by the Forest Minister, Adv. K. Raju, jointly organized by IISER Thiruvananthapuram and Christ Nagar English Higher Secondary School. On the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> of August, Volunteers cleaned the campus premises. As part of 'Swatch Pakawara' programme,

we conducted a campus rally on 5<sup>th</sup> of August. On 10<sup>th</sup> of August our unit participated in a flood relief collection camp jointly organized by 'Signature S5 Nishagandhi' and Trivandrum corporation. On the 14<sup>th</sup> of August, we conducted a declamation contest "patriotism& Nation building" with the assistance of Nehru Yuva Kendra. 73<sup>rd</sup> Independence Day was celebrated on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2019 in the college campus by hoisting the tricolour flag. It was a grant celebration with several cultural programmes. On 22<sup>nd</sup> of August, 40 volunteers participated in a special convocation ceremony, conducted in the Kerala University Senate hall, to honour Shri. Krish Gopala Krishnan and Dr. Jayant V. Narikar with doctorate degree.

The month of October started with the observation of 'Gandhi Jayanthi' on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2019. NSS volunteers devoted this day to campus cleaning. In association with the Economics department, our NSS units organized an awareness class upholding the message by Gandhiji, "My Life is My Message". On the same day, a class on 'Anti-Narcotism' was conducted by our NSS units with Ms. Dhanya Ravi as the speaker. ASI Mr Shajahan also addressed the gathering. On 5<sup>th</sup> October, our volunteer Hridya G M participated in a state level leadership camp entitled 'Trial 2019', conducted by BJM College in Chavara, Kollam. On 18<sup>th</sup> October, 55 volunteers cleaned our NSS room and its premises. A blood donation camp was organized by our NSS units in association with Nehru Yuva Kendra & HDFC Bank on 25<sup>th</sup> October, 2019. A total of 125 volunteers participated in the event.

In the month of January 2020, we were able to conduct an awareness class by joining in hands with Nehru Yuva kendra in connection with National Youth Day. Swami Athmadas Yami Dharmapaksha delivered a speech on 13<sup>th</sup> January 2020. A survey was taken on the adopted village named
