

PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO THE FIRST DEGREE PROGRAMME UNDER CHOICE BASED CREDIT AND SEMESTER (CBCS) SYSTEM, AND CAREER RELATED FIRST DEGREE PROGRAMME IN THE COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO THE UNIVERSITY OF KERALA AND CENTRES OF THE UNIVERSITY FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-19.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Prospectus for admission to the First Degree Programme [FDP] Under Choice Based Credit and Semester (CBCS) system and Career-related First Degree Programme in Government/Aided/*Self Financing Affiliated Colleges/University Institutes of Technology (UIT) for the academic year 2018-2019, as approved by the University of Kerala, is published herewith. It contains general information and rules relating to the admission to the FDP under CBCS system and Career-related First Degree Programme in Govt./Aided/Self Financing Affiliated Colleges & Centres of the University.
- 1.2 The prospectus issued during the previous years for admission to FDP under CBCS system is not valid for the year 2018-2019.
- 1.3 Admissions to the seats to be filled by the University to the First Degree Programmes (except those specifically mentioned) are regulated on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination. The details of seats to which admissions are made through the rank list prepared accordingly are contained in the relevant paragraphs. (Clause 4.1(d)).
- 1.4 Statute 19 of Chapter 24 of the KUFS 1977 which states that '**no student shall be admitted to any course of instruction in the Colleges in anticipation of Affiliation**', shall be strictly adhered to in all the Colleges.

2. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Choice Based Credit and Semester system was introduced in the University of Kerala from the academic year 2010 onwards and all the Undergraduate courses except BPED & BFA are known as First Degree Programmes. From the academic year 2012-2013 onwards, the admission to the First Degree Programme under CBCS system in the Arts and Science Colleges affiliated to the University of Kerala and Centres of the University were made on the basis of **Online Centralized Allotment**. The **Online allotment process** will provide the candidates, opportunity of obtaining admission to any of the Colleges of the University / Centres and to any of the programmes of his/her choice on the basis of merit.

Any candidate who desires to obtain admission under the University of Kerala for the First Degree Programme should compulsorily register online before the closure of registration, irrespective of the Category (General /SEBC/ BPL/ SC/ST/ Community /Management / Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep/Jammu and Kashmir/Tamil Linguistic Minority/Inmates of Government Children's Home / Persons With Disabilities (Differently Abled Persons) / widows /wards of Armed Forces Personnel, killed or disabled in action during peace time/ Sports etc.) to which he/she belongs.

The candidates who wish to apply for a First Degree Programme in Self-financing Colleges shall also register online before the closure of registration.

The allotment of the candidates to the various Programmes and Colleges will be on the basis of merit strictly following the rules and regulations regarding reservation. The marks at the Plus Two/Higher Secondary level would be the basic criteria for admission to the First Degree Programme.

The University will not be conducting online centralized allotment for the following First Degree Programmes/Courses and those candidates who wish to apply for the same need to apply directly to the Colleges concerned.

- a) All programmes for which Entrance test and aptitude tests are conducted for admission, like BFA, BPED, BPA & BA Music.
- b) Admission to all courses in NISH (National Institute of Speech & Hearing, Thiruvananthapuram) / Bishop Moore College of Hearing Impaired, Manakala, Adoor

Candidates seeking admission on passing SAY examination during the current Academic Year can register online before the Supplementary allotment. They will be considered in the supplementary allotment.

2.1 Authority to prescribe qualification for admission to the various courses of studies.

According to Sub-Section (v) and (vi) of Section 25 of the Kerala University Act, 1974, the Academic Council shall have the power to prescribe qualifications for admission of students to the various courses of study (and to the Examinations) and the conditions under which exemptions shall be granted, and to make provision for the admission of students to the various courses of studies on the basis of merit in order to maintain the standards of education.

2.2 Agreement for Direct Payment -Relevant provisions for admission to the various courses in aided colleges.

Article 18 of the Agreement for Direct Payment entered into between the Government and the Educational Agencies of Private Colleges stipulates that all future admission of students to the private affiliated colleges shall be on the following basis, viz.,

a) Twenty percent of the total number of seats in each college under the Educational Agency shall be reserved for students belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. Those seats which cannot be filled on this basis shall be filled on the basis of merit from among backward minority communities, in case the college is run by a backward minority community and from among OBCs, in all other cases.

b) *Ten/Twenty **percent of the seats shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to the community to which the college belongs. These seats will be filled strictly on the basis of merit from among the students of the said community.

c) *Fifty/Forty **percent of the seats will be filled by open selection on the basis of merit.

d) The remaining seats will be filled by the Educational Agency by candidates of their choice.

Note: *This will apply to Forward Community Colleges

 ** This will apply to Backward Community Colleges

3. PROGRAMMES, INSTITUTIONS AND SEATS

3.1 Details of the Programme and Duration: The Programme leads to Bachelors Degree in the relevant subject. Each Programme extends for a period of six semesters. The Programme of study shall be by regular attendance for the requisite number of lectures, practical training and other means.

Students shall be admitted to the First Degree Programmes in the Faculties of Science, Applied Sciences and Technology, Arts, Fine Arts, Social Sciences, Oriental Studies, Management Studies, Commerce conducted in the Affiliated Colleges and the Centers of the University.

The First Degree Programmes shall include 1) Language Courses 2) Foundation Courses 3) Core Courses in the Major Subjects related to Degree Programmes 4) Complementary Courses on allied subjects 5) Open Course 6) Elective Courses and 7) Project/Dissertation. In the case of subjects included in 2 (a), there shall be a component of Vocational Course. The minimum number of Courses required for the completion of a Degree Programme may vary from 30- 38 depending on the Credits assigned to different Courses.

The Vocational, Triple Main and Restructured Courses are renamed as Career-related First Degree Programmes. The Career-related programmes are classified as 2 (a) and 2(b). Programmes offered under 2 (a) have English and Additional Language and Programmes offered under 2 (b) has no additional language.

Programmes offered under 2 (a) are:

1. Biochemistry & Industrial Micro Biology
2. Botany and Biotechnology
3. BPA (Vocal, Veena, Violin, Mridangam and Dance)
4. Chemistry & Industrial Chemistry
5. Commerce & Hotel Management and Catering
6. Commerce & Tax Procedure and Practice
7. Commerce and Tourism and Travel Management.
8. Communicative Arabic

9. English & Communicative English
10. Environmental Science & Environment and Water Management
11. Journalism and Mass Communication
12. Malayalam and Mass Communication
13. Physics & Computer Application

Programmes offered under 2 (b) are:

1. Biotechnology (Multimajor)
2. Business Administration
3. Commerce with Computer Application
4. Computer Applications
5. Computer Science
6. Electronics
7. Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS) – Hotel Management
8. Bachelor of Social Work (BSW).

3.2 Institutions and Subjects for the First Degree Programme : The List of Colleges affiliated to the University of Kerala and the subjects offered in each institution are given as **Annexure I**, of the Prospectus.

3.3 Categorization of Seats: Seats available in Govt./Aided/Self financing affiliated Colleges are mainly classified as Merit Seats, Community Seats, Management Seats and Reservation Seats.

(a) Merit Seats: The seats that are filled by the University in Government/Aided/Self-financing Affiliated Colleges purely on the basis of merit are classified as 'Merit Seats'.

(b) Community Seats: The seats in Aided Colleges that are filled by the Management concerned, on the basis of merit among their community candidates, are classified as 'Community Seats'.

(c) Management Seats: The seats in Aided and Self-financing Affiliated Colleges that are filled by the Managements concerned are classified as 'Management Seats'.

(d) Reservation Seats: The seats in Government/Aided/Self-financing Affiliated Colleges, which are earmarked for SC/ST/SEBC/BPL/PWD/ Tamil Linguistic Minority/ Sports persons are classified as 'Reservation Seats'.

4. RESERVATION OF SEATS

Apart from the merit seats, the seats earmarked for SC/ST candidates in Government/ Aided/ Self-financing Colleges will be filled by the University. In addition to this, SEBC seats in Government /Self-financing colleges also will be filled by the University.

A candidate can claim only one benefit at a time as per his/her choice for a particular purpose.

4.1 Types of Reservation: Seats will be reserved for the following categories in Govt., Aided and Self financing Affiliated Colleges for various First Degree Programmes.

- (a) Reservation for Nominees
- (b) Reservation for Persons With Disabilities (Differently Abled Persons)
- (c) Special Reservation and
- (d) Mandatory Reservation.

4.1.1 Reservation for Nominees

(i) Reservation for Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep.

An additional seat shall be created for each First Degree Programme (wherever necessary) in any Govt. /Aided college, exclusively for the purpose of accommodating students sponsored by the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. This seat shall not be filled up by other candidates. The Head of the Institutions should forward the list of such candidates admitted, separately, to the University immediately after the admissions. (Govt. letter No.5455/B3/2006/H.Edn. dated 15-3-2006) (U.O.No.AcB/1/1134/2006 dated 26-4-2006). The students should register online before or after obtaining admission.

(ii) Concession for Wards of Kashmiri Migrants

The following relevant concessions are applicable for wards of Kashmiri Migrants for admission to the UG courses in all Affiliated Arts & Science Colleges – U.O.No.Ac.B1/910/Admns/2012, dated 09/04/2012.

- * Extension in date of admission by about 30 days.
- * Relaxation in cut off percentage up to 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
- * Increase in intake capacity upto 5% course wise.
- * Waiving of domicile requirements.
- * Facilitation of migration in second and subsequent years.

(iii) Reservation for Candidates from Jammu and Kashmir.

2 seats shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength to accommodate candidates belonging to Jammu & Kashmir for admission to UG/PG courses in the affiliated colleges from the academic year 2013-14 as per UO No. Ac B1/2292/Adms/2012 dated 01.03.2013.

(iv) Reservation for Inmates of Government Children's Home.

One seat shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength in each Govt/Private Aided Colleges for Inmates of Government Children's Home and Establishment as per UO.No. Ac B1/055682/2012 dated 30.04.2013.

(v) Reservation for Tamil Linguistic Minority (TLM).

5% seats of the sanctioned strength shall be created, over and above, for candidates belonging to Tamil Linguistic Minority in the following colleges as per GO (Ms) No. 148/96/H Edn dtd 01.08.1996.

- University College, Thiruvananthapuram
- Govt. Arts College, Thiruvananthapuram
- K.N.M Govt. Arts & Science College, Kanjiramkulam
- Govt. College, Kariavattom
- Govt. College for Women, Thiruvananthapuram

Such candidates should opt Tamil as Second Language, if offered by the college.

(vi) Reservation of seats for the widows /wards of Armed Forces Personnel, killed/disabled in action during peace time.

Additional seats over and above the sanctioned strength may be created as and when required for the widows /wards of Armed Forces Personnel, killed or disabled in action during peace time, in Central /State Universities /Autonomous/ Professional / Non-Professional Institutions under the purview of Ministry of Human Resource Development as per UGC policy.

4.1.2 Reservation for Persons with Disabilities (PWD)-(Differently Abled Persons)

(i) 5% seats of the sanctioned strength shall be created, over and above, exclusively for Physically Handicapped candidates in Government/ Aided Colleges (as per clause 32(l) of chapter VI, The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016).

(ii) In all other affiliated Colleges, three seats for each programme (BA/BSc/BCom) are created over and above sanctioned strength for physically handicapped candidates for admission to First Degree Programme except First Degree Programme in Geology. Out of the three seats, one seat each shall be reserved for the three sections of the disabled viz. the blind, the deaf and the orthopedically handicapped with provision for inter exchange of seat if candidates are not available in a particular category. **There will be no reservation for the blind for Science Programme.**

As per Clause 2 (r), Chapter I of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, 'Person with benchmark disability' means a person with not less than 40% of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority. Candidates who have a minimum of 40% disability alone will be eligible to apply for this quota. Candidates seeking admission under PWD category should submit the 'Certificate of

disability', issued not earlier than 5 years prior to the submission of application, by the District Medical Board or bodies of higher status, certifying the degree of percentage of disability. Based on the details furnished in the online application, candidates will be provisionally included under the 'Persons with Disability' category.

Authorities of all Educational Institutions/Colleges affiliated to the University of Kerala are directed to make appropriate arrangements for medical examination of students with disabilities at the place of counseling/admission, in case, the authenticity of disability certificate being produced by the candidate is doubted. Otherwise, the disability certificate issued by the appropriate authority should suffice. (Circular No. Ac.BI/PH/2011, dated 26.02.2011).

Note: The selection of candidates under this category will be based on the rank in the inter-merit list and physical suitability and not on the basis of the Degree of disability.
No reservation of seat is allowed for Blind candidates for Science subjects.

4.1.3 SPECIAL RESERVATION

Sportsperson

One seat over and above the sanctioned strength, shall be reserved for Sports candidates in each subject for the First Degree Programme (U.O. No.Ac.B1/04 dated 07-08-2004). In addition to these seats, two additional seats, over and above the sanctioned strength, shall be created for allotment exclusively for Sports candidates in First Degree Programme in each Arts & Commerce subjects. Admission to such seats shall be made by the Principal, as per the existing procedure for admission under Sports Quota. If the required number of sportspersons is not available, the seats should be kept vacant and shall not be filled by other candidates. (U.O. No. Ac.B1/2004 dated 08-07-2005).

Norms for Admission to the Seats Reserved under Sports Quota for UG Courses.

1. Representing the country and Winning the I/II/III in the International competitions (Olympics, Approved World Competitions, Approved World University Competitions, Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, Afro Asian Games, SAF Games, South Asian Championships etc.)
2. Representing the country in International competitions (Olympics, Approved World Competitions, Approved World University Competitions, Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, Afro Asian Games, SAF Games, South Asian Championships etc.).
3. Winning the I/II/III in the Senior National Championships.
4. Winning the I/II/III/IV in the All India Inter- University Competitions.
5. Representing the Senior State in National Championships.
6. Winning the I/II/III in the Junior/ Youth National Championships.
7. Winning the I/II/III/IV in the Zonal Inter- University Competitions.
8. Representing Senior State in South Zone Championships.
9. Representing University in Inter University Competitions.
10. Member of University team.
11. Winning I/II/III in All India School Games.
12. Representing the State in the Junior/ Youth National Championships.
13. Representing the State in the All India School Games.
14. Winning I/II/III in National PYKKA Competitions/ National Inter School Tournaments.
15. Representing the State in National PYKKA Competitions/ National Inter School Tournaments.
16. Representing the State in the Junior/ Youth Zone Championships.
17. Winning I/II/III place in the State School games.
18. Winning I/II/III place in the All Kerala Inter-collegiate (College Games)/ University Inter-collegiate competitions.
19. Winning I/II/III place in the Senior Inter District Championships.
20. Representing the Senior District and participating in the State Championships.
21. Representing ICSE/CBSE/Central School/ Navodaya Vidyalaya and winning I/II/III in the National Championships.
22. Winning I/II/III place in the State Junior/ Youth Championships.
23. Winning I/II/III place in State PYKKA Competitions.

24. Representing State in the Rural National/ Women festival.
25. Participating in the State School Games.
26. Winning I/II/III in the Senior/ Junior District and participating in the Zonal Championships.
27. Winning I/II/III in the Polytechnic /ITI and winning I/II/III in the State Championships.
28. Representing State in the Central School/ ICSE / CBSE/Navodaya Vidyalaya and participating in the National Championships.
29. Winning I/II/III place in District level PYKKA Competitions.
30. Winning I/II/III place in Revenue District School games.
31. Winning I/II/III place in the Educational District School games.

General Guidelines

- i) For filling up the seats reserved under Sports quota, hierarchy of preference shall be given as per the norms/guidelines formulated by the University in addition to his /her satisfying academic eligibility
- ii) When the candidates fulfil minimum academic eligibility, the academic merit shall not be preferred over sports merit in sports quota reservation seats except in the case of a tie in the sports merit.
- iii) The original certificate/s from the Competent authority/ authorities (Secretary, Organiser etc. as per the Circular Letter No. Ad.D1.3.1276 /74 dated 23.01.1979) must be produced by the candidate to prove his/her claim.
- iv) The verification of the certificate/s shall be done by the Director of Physical Education of the University /Head of the Department of Physical Education of the College.
- v) For securing admission to UG programmes under Sports Quota, including re-admission, the performance of the candidate during the preceding two years/ Higher Secondary Level shall be considered.
- vi) Preferences shall be given to those disciplines which have All India Inter- University competitions.

In case of a tie with respect to the sports merit, preference shall be given to that candidate who represents the discipline (game /sport) of the choice of the college concerned.

The above candidates should also register online before the closure of registration. The Principals of the Colleges shall then prepare the ranklist, based on the achievement in sports. Admissions shall be made after obtaining the approval of the University.

***Candidates who enjoy Communal Reservation such as SEBC, SC/ST who have BPL endorsement in the Ration Card are NOT eligible for BPL reservation. Only candidates belonging to FORWARD COMMUNITIES who are Economically Backward are eligible for BPL reservation. Such candidates must produce BPL Certificate from the Village Officer/Revenue Authority /Local Body concerned along with community certificate from the competent authority. In case of failure to specify the community, the candidate shall not be eligible for reservation in the BPL category.**

Note: (a) Thiyya and Billava will be considered as Ezhava Community for reservation.
(b) SEBC candidates should produce Non Creamy layer Certificate for getting the benefit of reservation.
(c) The enhancement of additional seats in Government colleges and University departments shall not incur any additional financial commitment to the Government/University.

1. The seats under community quota in Aided Colleges will be filled by the Management concerned on the basis of merit and on the basis of community certificate issued by the Revenue Authorities/Parish Priest/any other Competent Authority.
 2. All admissions to Community Quota (including the vacant seats of SC converted in case of Aided Backward colleges with Minority status) are to be effected from the Community Quota Ranklist prepared and published in the colleges.

(c) Self-Financing Affiliated Colleges: 50% seats will be filled on the basis of merit as detailed below.

The remaining 50% of the seats shall be filled by the management, by candidates of their choice, observing the prescribed eligibility conditions. **The candidates who apply under management quota shall also register online before closure of admission.**

The management quota applications can be used only for admission to management quota seats.

Note: The fee structure of the Self-financing Colleges is higher than that of Govt/Aided Colleges. Government fee concession is not available to candidates enjoying communal reservation, if admitted in Self- financing Colleges.

5. CLAIMS FOR MANDATORY RESERVATION AND CERTIFICATES TO BE PRODUCED

- (i) Claims for Mandatory Reservations must be made by a candidate at the time of submission of online application. Candidates should mention their claim in the **relevant columns** in the Personal and Academic Data Sheet. They should also satisfy the eligibility conditions as per the Prospectus at the time of Online registration.
- (ii) Candidates should produce all original documents to prove their claims made in the online application form at the time of admission before the Principal. **Claims that are not mentioned at the time of online submission of application will not be entertained even if supporting evidences are produced later on.** The claims for **mandatory** reservation once made cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstances.

5.1.1 Claim for Communal reservation under 'Socially and Educationally Backward Classes' (SEBC):

Reservation of seats to the Socially and Educationally backward Classes will be in accordance with the provisions contained in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. Dated 2.5.1966, as amended from time to time.

- Candidates belonging to Ezhava, Muslim, Other Backward Hindus, Latin Catholic/SIUC and Other Backward Christian communities, claiming reservation under SEBC quota should invariably produce 'Non Creamy layer Certificate' obtained from the Village Officer concerned. Candidate belonging to

Non Creamy Layer category only are eligible for claiming reservation to SEBC category. Annual Income is not a criteria for reservation for SEBC candidates.

- OEC community will be considered along with OBH/OBX community for reservation
- Applicants claiming reservation under Community quota in aided Colleges, who belong to the community of the Management which runs the college, will have to produce community certificate from the Revenue authority/Parish Priest/any other competent authority concerned, along with the application.

5.1.2 Claim for Reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes quota

(a) Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes quota should obtain the caste/community certificate from the Village Officer/Tahsildar.

Warning: Those who produce false SC/ST Certificate for claiming reservation under SC/ST quota shall be liable for penalties as per rules.

(b) **Claim of OEC candidates against the un-availed seats of SC/ST candidates.**

Other Eligible Community (OEC) candidates who claim allotment to the un-availed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota should furnish community and income certificates obtained from the Village Officer/Tahsildar. OEC candidates who possess 'Non Creamy layer Certificate' obtained from the Village Officer concerned alone are eligible for such seats.

Converted Christians do not come under the SC/ST category. They belong to OEC category. Refer Annexure IV.

5.2 OTHER GENERAL RULES FOR MANDATORY RESERVATION

5.2.1 If sufficient candidates are not available for filling the seats reserved for SC/ST candidates, the same will be notified in the media and a separate allotment for SC/ST candidates will be made by the University. However, even after this, if SC/ST seats are still vacant, such seats in Government Colleges will be filled by candidates belonging to OEC. In other Aided/Unaided Colleges, vacant SC/ST seats will be filled as per Govt. rules.

5.2.2 Claim for fee concession to OEC candidates: Candidates belonging to Other Eligible Communities are exempted from payment of fee at the time of allotment to First Degree Programme under Government/Community quota irrespective of annual family income as per G.O (MS) No. 36/07/SCSTDD, dated: 03.07.2007. **They should provide Community certificate from the Village Officer/Tahsildar at the time of admission.**

5.2.3 The seats for reservation under TLM, RPWD and sports quota are created over and above the sanctioned strength.

5.3 NATIVITY

5.3.1 Candidate should be an Indian citizen. Candidates seeking admission to First Degree Programme will be categorized as **Keralite** and **Non-Keralite**

(i) **Keralite:** A candidate of Kerala origin will be categorized as a Keralite. **Children of All India Service Officers allotted to Kerala Cadre are deemed to be Keralites** as per G.O. (Rt) No.822/08/H.Edn. dated 9-5-2008. But they will not be eligible for communal/special reservation.

(ii) **Non-Keralite:** A candidate who does not come under Keralite category will be categorized as Non-Keralite. Such a candidate will be eligible for admission only after all the applicants of Keralite origin are ranked and allotted. Such candidates are not eligible for Communal, Special, PWD reservations or any kind of fee concession.

5.3.2 In order to prove that a candidate is an Indian citizen of Kerala origin for the limited purpose of eligibility for admission, he/she has to produce any one of the following certificates at the time of admission.

- (a) In the case of candidates who have undergone schooling in Kerala, a course certificate from the head of the educational institution last attended in Kerala, certifying that the candidate has

PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE DEGREE COURSES IN GOVT/AIDED/ SELF-FINANCING ARTS AND SCIENCE COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO THE UNIVERSITY OF KERALA & CENTRES OF THE UNIVERSITY FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR: 2017-2018

1. INTRODUCTION

Prospectus for admission to the Post Graduate (PG) Degree Courses in Govt./Aided/Self financing Affiliated Colleges & Centres of the University, for the academic year **2017-18**, as approved by the University of Kerala, is published herewith. It contains general information and rules relating to the admission to PG Degree Courses in Govt./Aided/Self financing affiliated Colleges under the University of Kerala & Centres of the University.

1.2 *The Prospectus issued by the University and various colleges during the previous years for PG admissions are not valid for the year 2017-18.*

1.3 Admissions to the seats to be filled by the University for the PG courses (except those specifically mentioned) are regulated on the basis of grade/marks obtained in the qualifying examination. The details of seats, to which admissions are made through the rank list prepared accordingly, are contained in the relevant paragraphs.

1.4 Statute 19 (3), of Chapter 24 of the KUFS.1977 which states that 'no student shall be admitted to any course of instruction in the colleges in anticipation of affiliation', shall be strictly adhered to, in all the colleges.

1.5 **Authority to prescribe qualification for admission to the various courses of studies.**

According to Sub-Section (v) and (vi) of Section 25 of the Kerala University Act, 1974, the Academic Council shall have the power to prescribe qualifications for admission of students to the various courses of study (and to the Examinations) and the conditions under which exemptions shall be granted, and to make provision for the admission of students to the various courses of studies on the basis of merit in order to maintain the standards of education.

1.6 **Agreement for Direct Payment - Relevant provisions for admission to the various courses in aided colleges.**

Article 18 of the Agreement for Direct Payment entered into between the Government and the Educational Agencies of Private Colleges stipulates that all future admission of students to the Private Affiliated Colleges shall be on the following basis, viz :-

a) Twenty percent of the total number of seats in each college under the Educational Agency shall be reserved for students belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. Those seats which cannot be filled on this basis shall be filled on the basis of merit from among backward minority communities, in case the college is run by a backward minority community and from among OBCs, in all other cases.

b) *Ten/Twenty **percent of the seats shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to the community to which the college belongs. These seats will be filled strictly on the basis of merit from among the students of the said community.

c) *Fifty/Forty **percent of the seats will be filled by open selection on the basis of merit.

d) The remaining seats will be filled by the Educational Agency by candidates of their choice.

*Note: * This will apply to Forward Community Colleges*

*** This will apply to Backward Community Colleges.*

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. All candidates who wish to apply for PG Programme (irrespective of Category) must compulsorily register online, including Community Quota and Management Quota.
2. Those who wish to apply for admission under Community quota shall submit hard copy(Print out) of the application, to the respective colleges, within the time prescribed by the University.
3. The candidates who are applying for Sports Quota should specifically mention the same during the Online Registration. They will be considered for General merit seats also. Such candidates should take the hard copy of the application and submit it to the respective Colleges where they wish to be considered under Sports Quota along with the attested copies of the supporting documents.
4. The candidates who come under the PWD (Persons With Disability-Differently Abled) quota should specifically mention the same at the time of online registration.
5. The candidates applying for Management quota seats / Special reservation Nominees should register online before the closure of admission.

After completion of the online registration, the candidate should take the print out of the same. **DO NOT SEND HARD COPIES TO THE UNIVERSITY.** The hard copy of the online application with supporting documents should be kept by the candidate and it has to be submitted at the time of admission in the respective colleges.

6. Candidates coming under SC/ST/OEC/SEBC are not eligible for BPL reservation. Only the candidates belonging to the Forward communities who are economically backward are eligible for BPL reservation. A certificate from local body (Panchayat/Municipality/Corporation) to that effect along with community certificate from the competent authority shall be produced at the time of admission. In case of failure to specify the community, the candidate shall not be eligible for reservation in the BPL category.
- 1.7 Admission to the following PG courses will not come under the purview of Centralised Allotment Process. The eligibility criteria and admission procedures for the following courses shall be as prescribed in the 'Hand Book for Admission' of the University.
MBA, MCA, MAHRM, MPE, MSW, MFA, and MASLP.

2. COURSES, INSTITUTIONS AND SEATS

2.1 Details of Courses and Duration:

The course leads to Masters Degree in the relevant subject. The course extends for a period of four semesters. The course of study shall be by regular attendance for the requisite number of lectures, practical training and other means.

2.2 Institutions and Subjects for the PG Degree Courses:

The list of colleges to which admissions are to be made and the subjects offered and the total strength in each institution are given as Annexure –I, in the Prospectus

2.3 Categorization of Seats:

Seats available in Govt/Aided/Self financing Affiliated Colleges are mainly classified as Merit Seats/Community seats/Management seats and Reservation seats.

a. Merit Seats:

The seats that are to be filled by the University in Government/Aided/Self financing Affiliated Colleges are classified as "Merit Seats."

b. Community Seats:

The seats in aided Colleges that are filled by the Management concerned, on the basis of merit among their community candidates, are classified as "Community Seats."

c. Management Seats:

The seats in Aided and Self-financing affiliated Colleges that are to be filled by the Managements concerned are classified as "Management Seats."

d. Reservation Seats:

The seats in Government/Aided/Self-financing affiliated Colleges/Centres of the University that are earmarked for SC/ST/SEBC/BPL/PWD/Reservation for Nominees/Sports persons are classified as "Reservation Seats."

3. RESERVATION OF SEATS

Apart from the merit seats, the seats earmarked for SC/ST candidates in Government/Aided/Self-financing Colleges/Centres of the University will be filled by the University. In addition to this, SEBC seats in Government/Self-financing Colleges also will be filled by the University.

3.1 Types of Reservations:

Seats will be reserved for the following categories in Government/Aided/Self-financing Colleges/UTs for various PG courses.

- a. Reservation for Nominees
- b. Reservation for Persons With Disabilities
- c. Special Reservation
- d. Mandatory Reservation
- e. Reservation of seats for the Widows/Wards of Armed Forces Personnel killed/disabled in action

3.1.1 Reservation for Nominees:

a. An additional seat shall be created in all Government/Aided Colleges exclusively for the purpose of accommodating students sponsored by the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. This seat shall not be filled up by other candidates. The Head of the Institutions should forward the list of such candidates admitted, separately, to the University, immediately after admissions (Govt. Letter No.5455/B3/2006/H Edn., dated 15.03.2006) (U.O.No.Ac.B/ 1/1134/2006 dated 26.04.2006). They should also register online before or after admission.

b. Two additional seats shall be created in all Affiliated Colleges exclusively for the purpose of accommodating candidates belonging to Jammu & Kashmir for admission to PG courses from the academic year 2014 – 2015 onwards (U.O.No.Ac.B1/2292/Admns/2012 dated 01.03.2013). Such students should also register online before or after admission and approach Colleges for admission and the Principal should forward the list of such candidates after admission. These seats shall not be filled up by other candidates.

C. One Seat each be created for each PG course (only wherever necessary) in all affiliated Arts & Science Colleges under University of Kerala exclusively for the purpose of accommodating Malayalee students of Andaman. The colleges shall submit the list of such admitted students to the University, immediately after admissions along with the documents to prove that the student belongs to the Malayalee community in Andaman. This seat shall not be filled up by other candidates.

3.1.2 Reservation for Persons With Disabilities (PWD)-Differently Abled Persons

3% of the total seats will be set apart exclusively for physically handicapped candidates in Government Colleges. The remaining seats will be considered as one single unit for providing reservation mentioned in the Government Order [G.O [Ms] No.107/08/Higher Edn dated 30/08/2008, and corresponding UO dated 20/09/2008. The applicants under this quota will be selected on the basis of existing rules.

1. One seat for each Post Graduate course in all other Colleges shall be reserved for Physically Handicapped candidates.
2. These seats are over and above the sanctioned strength of the Course/subjects in the College and the same will be sanctioned by the University every year.

As per Clause 2 (t), Chapter I of the Persons with Disabilities Act 1995, "Person with disability" means a person suffering from not less than 40% of any disability as certified by a Medical Board constituted for this purpose. Candidates who have a minimum of 40% disability alone will be eligible to apply for this quota.

Candidates seeking admission under PWD category should attach "Certificate of disability" , issued not earlier than 5 years prior to the admission, by the District Medical Board or bodies of higher status,

certifying the degree of percentage of disability. Authorities of all Educational Institutions/College affiliated to the University of Kerala are directed to make appropriate arrangements for Medical examination of students with disabilities at the place of counselling/admission, in the event of the authenticity of disability certificate being produced by the candidate is in doubt. Otherwise, the disability certificate issued by the appropriate authority should suffice. (Circular No.Ac.BI/PH/2011, dated 26.02.2011).

- ❖ The selection of candidates under this category will be based on the rank in the inter-se merit list and not on the basis of the degree of disability.
- ❖ **No reservation of seats is allowed for Blind candidates for Science subjects.**
- ❖ In Government Colleges, the seats remaining vacant due to the non-availability of candidates under “Persons with Disability” category, will go to the **open merit quota** unless otherwise mentioned.

3.1.3 Special Reservation: -

3.1.3(A) Sports Quota

One seat shall be given for sports persons over and above the sanctioned strength in each subject for the First Post Graduate Degree Programme. Admission to such seats shall be made as per the procedure for admission under sports quota. If the required number of sports persons is not available, the seats should be kept vacant and shall not be filled by other candidates.

Norms for Admission to the Seats Reserved Under Sports Quota for Post Graduate Courses

1. Representing the country and winning the I/II/III in the International Competitions (Olympics, Approved World Competitions, Approved World University Competitions, Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, Afro-Asian games, SAF Games, South Asian Championships etc.)
2. Representing the country in International Competitions (Olympics, Approved World Competitions, Approved World University Competitions, Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, Afro-Asian Games, SAF Games, South Asian Championships etc.)
3. Winning the I/II/III in the Senior National Championships.
4. Winning the I/II/III/IV in the All India Inter -University Competitions.
5. Representing Senior State in National Championships.
6. Winning the I/II/III in the Junior/Youth National Championships.
7. Winning the I/II/III/IV in the Zonal Inter-University Competitions.
8. Representing Senior State in South Zone Championship.
9. Representing University in Inter -University Competitions.
10. Representing the state in the Junior/Youth National Championships.
11. Representing the state in the Junior/Youth Zone Championships.
12. Winning the I/II/III place in the All Kerala Inter-Collegiate (College Games) organized by Kerala Sports Council.
13. Winning the I/II/III place in the Senior/Junior Inter District Championships.
14. Participating in the State Championships.

General Guidelines

- i. For filling up the seats reserved under Sports quota, hierarchy of preference shall be given as further norms/guidelines formulated by the University in addition to his/her satisfying academic eligibility.

- ii. When the candidates fulfill minimum academic eligibility, the academic merit shall not be preferred over Sports merit in Sports quota reservation seats, except in the case of a tie in the sports merit.
- iii. The original certificate/s from the Competent authority/ authorities (Secretary, Organizer etc. as per the Circular Letter No.Ad.D1.3.1276/74 dtd 23.01.1979) must be produced by the candidate to prove his/her claim.
- iv. The verification of the certificate/s shall be done by the Director of Physical Education of the University/ Head of the Department of Physical Education of the College.
- v. For securing admission to PG programmes under Sports quota, including readmission, the performance of the candidate during the preceding three years shall be considered.
- vi. Preferences shall be given to those disciplines which have All India Inter-University Competitions.
- vii. In case of a tie, with respect to the Sports merit, preference shall be given to that candidate who represents the discipline (Game/Sport) of the choice of the college concerned. The college shall be asked to submit their home discipline at the beginning of each academic year.

Note: The candidates who are applying for Sports Quota should specifically mention the same during the Online Registration. They will also be considered for General merit seats.

3.1.3(B) Arts Quota

Students who are declared as Kalaprabhitha / Kalathilakam of the University of Kerala in any year during their Degree course, and who are applicants for PG Course in a College affiliated to this University, during the succeeding academic year shall be admitted to the PG course/College of his/her first option, if otherwise eligible, by creating seats over and above the sanctioned strength.

3.1.4 Mandatory Reservation

- 3.1.4. a Leaving the seats set apart for Persons With Disabilities, the remaining seats for each course in Govt. Colleges will be distributed as per the G.O (MS) No.107/08/H.Edn. dated 30.8.08 and corresponding U.O AcB/I/Adms BC/2008 dated 20.9.2008.

Candidates who enjoy communal reservation such as SEBC, SC/ST who have **BPL endorsement in the Ration Card are not eligible for BPL reservations**. Only candidates belonging to Forward Communities who are Economically Backward are eligible for BPL reservations. Such candidates must produce BPL certificate from the Village Officer/Revenue Authority/Local Body concerned along with community certificate from the competent authority. **In case of failure to specify the community, the candidate shall not be eligible for reservation in the BPL category.**

Note: As per U.O AcB/I/Admns BC/2008 dated 20.09.2008, for reservation of 20% seats under SEBC, the total seats for PG courses in a college will be taken as one unit. If necessary, for allotment of such seats, rotation system will be followed.

Note: (a) Thiyya and Billava will be considered as Ezhava Community for reservation.

(b) SEBC candidates should produce Non Creamy layer Certificate for getting the benefit of reservation.

(c) The enhancement of additional seats in Government colleges and University Departments shall not incur any additional financial commitment to the Government/ University.

3.1.4. b In Affiliated Aided Colleges, seats for each course will be distributed as per the existing pattern given below:

Note: The seats under community quota in Aided Colleges will be filled on the basis of merit and on the basis of Community Certificate issued by the Revenue Authorities/Parish Priest/any other Competent Authority. The remaining seats (20%) will be filled by the Educational Agency (ie. Management) with candidates of its own choice. The academic eligibility of such candidates shall be the same as prescribed in the Prospectus, 2017-18.

3.1.4.c In Self-Financing affiliated colleges 50% seats under Government quota will be filled on the basis of merit.

Note: The 50% of the seats under Management quota shall be filled by the Management from candidates of its own choice by observing the prescribed eligibility conditions, as per the prospectus.

3.1.5 Reservation of Seats for the Widows/Wards of Armed Forces Personnel Killed/Disabled in action

Additional seats over and above the sanctioned strength may be created as and when required for the widows/wards of Armed Forces Personnel killed/disabled in action during peace time in Central/State Universities/Autonomous Professional/Non-professional institutions under the purview of Ministry of Human Resources Development as per UGC policy.

4. CLAIMS FOR MANDATORY RESERVATION AND CERTIFICATES TO BE PRODUCED

Claims for Mandatory Reservations must be made by a candidate at the time of submission of online application. Candidates should also mention the item of reservation claimed in the relevant columns in the online application. Candidates should also satisfy the eligibility conditions as per Clause 5 of the Prospectus. **The claims for mandatory reservation once made in the application cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstances.**

4.1. Merit Seats: The seats under the Merit category will be filled purely on merit basis irrespective of the Category/Community to which the candidates belong.

4.1.2. Claim for Communal reservation under 'Socially and Educationally Backward Classes' (SEBC):

Reservation of seats to the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes will be in accordance with the

provisions contained in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. Dated 2.5.1966, as amended from time to time.

- a. Candidates belonging to Ezhava, Muslim, Other Backward Hindus, Latin Catholic/SIUC and Other Backward Christian communities, claiming reservation under SEBC quota should invariably produce both "Community" and 'Non Creamy layer Certificate' obtained from the Village Officer concerned. Candidate belonging to Non Creamy Layer category only are eligible for claiming reservation to SEBC category. Annual Income is not a criterion for reservation for SEBC candidates. Only the claims of the candidates of those communities that are included in the list of communities will be considered. (U.O.No. Ac.BI/UG Admns. BC/2011, dated 11.01.2012).
- b. Applicants claiming reservation under community quota in aided colleges (ref. Annexure I), who belong to the community of the Management which runs the college, will have to submit the Community Certificate obtained from the Revenue Authority/ Parish Priest/ any other Competent Authority concerned, along with the application to the college concerned.

4.1.3 Claim for Reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes Quota

- a. Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes quota should obtain the Caste/Community Certificate from the Tahsildar.

Those who produce false SC/ST Certificate for claiming reservation under SC/ST quota shall be liable for penalties as per rules.

- b. **Claim of OEC candidates against the un-availed seats of SC/ST candidates.**

Other Eligible Community (OEC) candidates who also come under SEBC Category, claiming allotment to the un-availed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota, should furnish Community and Non Creamy Layer Certificate obtained from the Village Officer concerned. OEC candidates belonging to Non Creamy Layer category alone are eligible for such seats. Other OEC candidates (not coming under SEBC Category) should furnish Community and Income Certificate obtained from the Village Officer concerned. OEC candidates with annual family income less than Rs. Six Lakh alone are eligible for such seats and such seats will be filled as per rules laid by the Govt.

Converted Christians do not come under the SC/ST category. They belong to OEC category. (Ref. Annexure IV)

4.2 Other General Rules for Mandatory Reservation

- 4.2.1 In the Government/Self-financing Colleges, if the seats reserved for SC/ST candidates are not filled up by them even after notifying the vacancies three times through the media (on three different dates), those seats may be filled up by candidates belonging to OEC, and in their absence, candidates belonging to SEBC as per the existing rules.

The seats that still remain un-availed will go to the Open Merit Quota.

In Backward community Colleges with Minority Status, if the seats reserved for SC/ST candidates are not filled up by SC/ST candidates even after notifying the vacancies three times through the media (on three different dates), those seats may be filled up by candidates belonging to the respective community.

In other aided Colleges, if the seats reserved for SC/ST candidates are not filled up by SC/ST candidates even after notifying the vacancies three times through the media (on three different dates), those seats may be filled up by candidates belonging to SEBC.

4.2.2 Claim for fee concession to OEC candidates:

Candidates belonging to Other Eligible Communities are exempted from payment of fee at the time of allotment to PG Degree Courses under Government/Community quota irrespective of annual family income as per G.O (MS) No. 36/07/SCSTDD, dated: 03.07.2007.

They should provide the Community Certificate from the Village Officer/ Tahsildar at the time of admission.

ORDER

As per Government order read as 2nd paper above 20% reservation was introduced for the students belonging to backward classes in degree and Post Graduate courses in Government colleges based on the findings of the Narendran Commission Report. The above said Government Order was kept in abeyance as per the letter read as 3rd paper above in view of the finding that total reservation exceeds 50% which is against the order of the Supreme Court.

As per the Government Order read as 4th paper above 3% reservation to Physically Handicapped students was incorporated in the community based reservation in order to overcome the difficulty of total reservation exceeding 50%. This Government Order could not be implemented since admission process had already started. Government issued instructions not to implement the reservation in Degree and Post Graduate courses until further, orders and to maintain status quo vide letter read as 5th paper above.

In the circumstances Government have seriously considered the matter of extending the reservation to backward classes in this academic year itself. It is observed that the number of seats in Colleges and University Departments have to be enhanced to provide reservation to backward classes as per existing rules of reservation since classes for this academic year have already commenced.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order the following.

- 1) 20% of the total seats existing in Government Colleges and University Teaching Departments will be enhanced and allotted to the communities belonging to backward classes. The percentage of reservation will be as follows.

Ezhava – 8%

Muslim – 7%

LEP/LUC – 1%

O.B.C Christian – 1%

O.B.C Hindu – 3%

- 2) Thiyya and Billava will be considered as Ezhava Community for the reservation.
- 3) Ezhava community is excluded from the reservation to O.B.C. Hindu Category. Since separate reservation has been provided to that Community.
- 4) For backward classes Annual Family Income will be below Rs.2.5 lakhs for getting the benefit of reservation.
- 5) The B.P.L. Certificate issued by the Village officer will be considered as the certificate of economic backwardness.
- 6) 3% of the total seats will be set apart exclusively for physically handicapped candidates. The remaining seats will be considered as one single unit for providing reservation mentioned in this Government Order.
- 7) The financial assistance now provided to Muslim and Nadar girls will be extended to the girls from other backward communities also.
- 8) The enhancement of additional seats in Government Colleges and University Departments will not incur any additional financial commitment to Government.
- 9) The Government orders cited 2nd and 4th and Government letters read above will stand cancelled.
