Ph.D Programme shall be for a minimum duration of three years, including a maximum of six years for both Full Time and Part Time after which the registration shall automatically lapse. However, women candidates and candidates with disability of more than 40 percent shall be allowed a relaxation of two years for Ph.D. in the maximum duration.

Part Time research scholars shall spend a period of at least 180 days at a stretch or in not more than three spells as full time research scholars at the centre of research before they are allowed to submit the thesis.

The course work for Ph.D. shall be of a minimum of 12 credits and a maximum of 16 credits.

All courses prescribed for Ph.D course work shall be in conformity with the credit hour instructional requirements and shall specify content, instructional and assessment methods duly approved by Academic Committee of CSS in the University.

The Department where the scholar pursues research shall prescribe the course (s) based on the recommendations of the Department Doctoral Committee.
